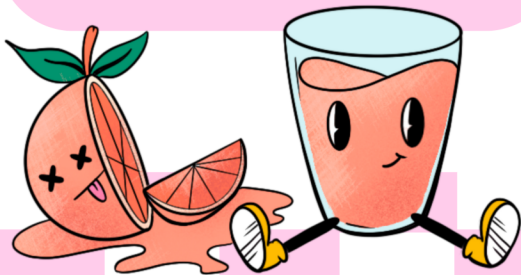

A breakfast menu for concerned Swifties who are wondering what Taylor Swift's recent admission to the billionaire club means.



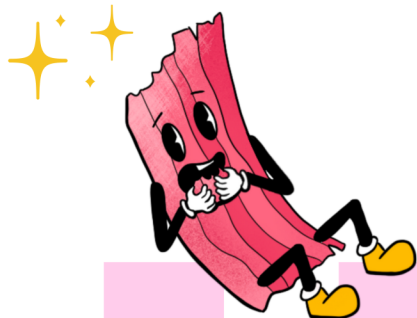
BILLIONAIRE BITES

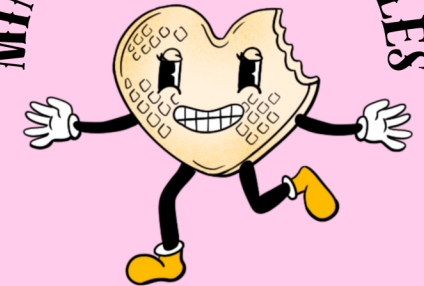
